For weeks the board has been working on the idea of including the Beaufort and Low Country Rotary Clubs in our Shrimp Race for the 2011 event. A subcommittee including Marc, Rion, Mike Mashke, Kathy, Tom and I met to look at a proposal developed by Marc and modeled after the Daniel Island Rotary Club agreement with clubs in Charleston. We will make a final decision at the May board meeting but want the entire membership to have the chance to voice an opinion. The basic parts to the proposal are below.

1. SIRC would have total control of the race. Any assistance from the other clubs would be voluntary.
2. All shrimp would be purchased and owned by SIRC along with the rights to the design/logo.
3. For every shrimp adoption conducted by the members of the other clubs (at the cost of \$10.00), \$5.00 would go to the club whose member conducts the adoption and \$5.00 will go to SIRC.
4. SIRC will pay for all expenses associated with the race.
5. The Beaufort and Low Country Clubs will sign a "no competition" agreement applicable to fifteen miles from the town of Beaufort and for three years (No water-type races with any kind of material).
6. The other two clubs will be given an adequate supply of marketing materials by SIRC.
7. If one or both of the other clubs agree to this proposal, a contract will be created with a one year term.

For more information and/or to voice opinion please talk to one of the members of the board prior to May 11. It is important to me and to the board for the general consensus of the club to be favorable before we move forward on this idea.
